ELIGIBILITY:

AGE: Candidate should have completed 17 years and should not be more than 35 years as on 31st December of the year of admission.

In case of SC / ST Candidates the maximum age shall be relaxed by 3 years. NO REQUEST FOR RELAXATION OF AGE OF A CANDIDATE SHALL BE ENTERTAINED. .

SEX: ONLY FEMALE CANDIDATES

QUALIFICATION:

Candidates seeking admission into B.Sc., Nursing 4years degree Course should have passed 2 Years Intermediate Examination (10+2 pattern) with Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology as optional, which shall include a practical test in each subject and English with minimum of 45% aggregate marks in optional subjects and English. In case of SC, ST candidates 5% relaxation. (I.e. 40%)

Any other equivalent examination (10+2 pattern) recognized by the University in A.P. or Board of Intermediate Education Andhra Pradesh with Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology as optional subjects, which shall include a practical test in each of these subjects and English with minimum of 45% aggregate marks in optional and English In case of SC, ST candidates 5% relaxation. (i.e., 40%)

Should have Passed Intermediate Vocational Course in Nursing (10+2) pattern / Intermediate Vocational Course in Multi Purpose Health Worker (MPHW) (10+2) pattern
Or Intermediate (10+2) with Bridge course with Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology
