ELIGIBILITY:

AGE: For both the Service and Non-Service candidates should not have completed 45 years of age as on 31st December of the year of admission. For candidates belonging to SC and ST's the maximum age limit shall be 48 years.

SEX: Women only.

EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION

The candidate should have passed B.Sc., (Nursing)/B.Sc., Hons (Nursing)/Post Basic B.Sc., (Nursing) from an Institution which is recognized by the Indian Nursing Council with minimum of 55% aggregate marks and 5% relaxation of marks for SC and ST candidates

EXPERIENCE:

Candidate should be a Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife of Indian Nursing Council for Service and Non-- Service candidates

Minimum one year of work experience after Registration of B.Sc., (Nsg.,) course as on June of the year of admission.

Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Registration of Post Basic B.Sc., (Nsg.,) courses on June of the year of admission.

PHYSICAL FITNESS: The candidate shall be medically fit.
